SUB: GUIDELINE FOR ON-LINE RETURN OF MATRICULATE FOR THE ACADEMIC SESSION 2011-12 ADMITTED STUDENT THROUGH E-ADMISSION UNDER PROJECT STUDENT ACADEMIC MANAGEMENT SYSTEM (SAMS).

Madam/Sir,

In inviting your kind reference to the Government Notification & subject cited above, I am directed to inform you that the Council has formulated the following procedures of Online Return of Matriculate (RoM) for the Academic Session 2011-12 admitted student through e-Admission under project Student Academic Management System (SAMS).

1. Return of Matriculate will be submitted by the last college where a student shall take final admission through their college e-Space (www.dheorissa.in).
2. **Process of on-line e-Space entry**
 - 2.1. Update the admission data as per the prescribed format given in the respective college e-Space under Other Information Update link.
 - 2.2. After data updation, please verify the updated data in your e-Space to ensure 100% correctness to the RoM.
 - 2.3. Then click on the "Online RoM (2011-12)" and take a print of stream wise RoM Report and sign on the each page of the report.
 - 2.4. A demand advice note will be generated in the software after the data updation. This will show the stream wise number of candidates RoM is submitted and amount to be transferred to CHSE through RTGS/NEFT/Intra Core Banking.
 - 2.5. Colleges are to take print of the demand advice note from the e-Space and transfer the consolidated RoM fees through any bank which has core banking facilities.
 - 2.6. After transferring the fees through RTGS/NEFT/ Intra Core Banking respective colleges have to send the money transfer information through e-Space i.e. Transaction Number, Date of Transaction, Bank Name & Branch through which money has been transferred.
 - 2.7. As soon as you click on the submit button, the RoM data information along with payment confirmation will be sent to CHSE through e-Space software. A bar coded confirmation slip in respect of the submission of on-line RoM data &

money transaction information will be generated, which is to be deposited during physical verification.

- 2.8. CHSE will reconcile the payment with bank statement and then confirm the receipt of the payment through e-Space.

Madam/Sir

In inviting a kind reference to the Government Resolution & subject cited above, I am directed to inform you that the council has formulated the following procedure for on-line submission & verification of Return of Matriculate, issue of on-line Registration Number and on-line Registration Card under project Student Academic Management System (SAMS) from the Academic Session 2011-12.

1. **Return of Matriculate will be submitted by the last college where a student shall take final admission.** A sample format is enclosed at **Annexure-1**. So when a student gets transfer from one college to a second college, the authority of the 1st college will return his/her Cancelled Original School Leaving Certificate along with the College Leaving Certificate to the student. The 2nd college will receive the Cancelled Original School Leaving Certificate along with College Leaving Certificate as essential documents for admission.
2. The cut-off date for finalizing the on-line submission of Return of Matriculate at college level is 15th January of following year i.e. for admission in 2011 the cut-off date would be 15th January 2012.
3. Recent colour passport size photograph is to be uploaded in e-Space against each admitted student before 15th January of each year. Without photograph the registration card will not be generated from e-Space by CHSE. This photograph will be used for all the purposes of CHSE like Registration Card, Admit Card, Migration Certificate, etc.
4. College authority has to publish the vital information related to the registration card in the college notice board for students, to intimate for its correction (if found wrong) to ensure 100% correctness of the data before 15th January of each year. A sample copy of the format is enclosed at **Annexure-2**. This information will be further used for generation Admit Card, Mark Sheet & Certificate purposes.

5. It may be noted that after 15th of January, software will restrict the data updation. Hence any request related to stream change, subject change by students shall be incorporated in the software before the due date i.e. 15th January each year.
6. The Return of Matriculate shall be in consonance with the sanctioned strength (Stream & Subject) granted by the Higher Education Department / Regional Directorates. If any discrepancy is found in this matter, the Principal of the college shall be held responsible solely for these irregularities.
7. The copy of the Affiliation Order/Recognition Order is to be submitted along with the Return of Matriculate for verification purposes.
8. After 15th January of each year, the college authority is to generate hard copy of the Return of Matriculate report from the e-Space and each page of the RoM should be duly signed before submit to CHSE (Onssa) as per the schedule along with the following documents.
 - 8.1. Each page of RoM duly signed in each page by Principal & Admission-in-Charge
 - 8.2. Original Cancelled School Leaving Certificate of each applicant.
 - 8.3. Photocopy of 10th Board Mark Sheet of each applicant.
 - 8.4. Migration Certificate in respect of other Boards / Councils.
 - 8.5. Old Registration receipt of the student in case of re-admission into 1st year
 - 8.6. Admission Register & Money Receipt
 - 8.7. Copy of Affiliation Order / Recognition Order.
 - 8.8. Requisite fees in shape of Bank Draft in favour of Finance Officer, CHSE, Orissa, payable at Bhubaneswar
9. After physical verification of all the documents, CHSE will confirm their RoM on-line in the e-Space. After confirmation, the Registration Number will be generated through SAMS software and sent to the students directly through SMS (if mobile number is available).
10. The Registration number will be the combination of CHSE college code & the roll number issued to the students in the e-Admission system. In 1st week of March of each year the Registration Number will be generated and the software generated registration card will be made available in the e-Space. After downloading the Registration Card, the Principal of the particular college will sign in the space provided and distribute the same to the students. A sample copy of Registration Card is enclosed at Annexure-3.
11. Under the following circumstances the Registration Number will not be issued to the student for which the student will be debarred from appearing the CHSE Annual Examination.
 - 11.1. Non-receipt of Affiliation Order / Recognition Order from the prescribed authorities.
 - 11.2. The submission of Return of Matriculates by the Institution within the stipulated period does not qualify the registration of the student if recognition is not granted by the prescribed authorities.
12. The Return of Matriculate will be verified at the four zones i.e. Central Zone at Bhubaneswar, Barpada Zone, Sambalpur Zone & Berhampur Zone. Colleges are required to submit their RoMs at their respective zones only and the verification will be done on same day in presence of the college representative. After verification officials of the zonal offices will report to the Head Office between 16th to 20th Feb to upload the data into e-Space after due approval by

CHSE authority Verification of Return of Matriculate will be done strictly adhering to the date lines scheduled by CHSE, Orissa. If any of the colleges does not turn up for verification a fine of Rs. 20,000/- (Rupees Twenty thousands) per college will be imposed within the fine date. After fine date no Return of Matriculate will be entertained. Zone wise cut-off date for RoM verification is given below.

- 13 The student of any stream, who have appeared / dropped and failed in Annual Examination, will not be allowed to appear in the next Annual Examination as regular candidates. Any deviation on this score will be treated as quite irregular by the Council. If such case is detected, in spite of warning, the concerned college will be held responsible.

N.B - Holidays falling on the above dates shall be considered and relaxed.

- (1) The Return of Matriculate (RoM) for the Academic Session 2011-12 shall be done online through SAMS, e-Admission Database.
- (2) The process of RoM shall be completed by 28-Feb-2012 in all respect along with online registration card distribution to the student through college e-Space.
- (3) The RoM fees shall be collected in separate bank account only through RTGS / NEFT / Intra Core Banking after deducting the fees towards SAMS Central Fund contribution.
- (4) Necessary guidelines are to be issued to the colleges at CHSE on or before 16-Jan-2012 positively.
- (5) Rs. 350/- as fine imposed earlier for form fill up from 05/01/2012 to 10/01/2012 is extended upto 24-Jan-2012. Accordingly CHSE will issue necessary instruction to the colleges and published in the newspaper for awareness of students/parents/common citizens.

Therefore, you are requested take necessary immediate steps to ensure the smooth & timely implementation of Online RoM.

I-A-HE-UA-2-2011 15601 (1291) /H.E., Dated: 15-Apr-2011, Government after careful consideration, have been pleased to take following decisions for smooth & timely implementation of e-Admission under project Student Academic Management System.

1. All types of admission into Junior Colleges / Higher Secondary Schools including transfer of admission from one college to another in the 1st year shall be completed by **31st December** of each year.
2. The last date of on-line submission of Return of Matriculate (RoM) in Council of Higher Secondary Education, Orissa is **15th January** of each year.
3. There will be no transfer in 2nd year classes from the academic session 2011-12 except under special circumstances. Transfer will be in special cases like Government / PSU / Banking Sector Servant on Transfer, Marriage of a girl student, etc with due approval of Government/CHSE. In such cases, intimation is to be given to OCAC for effecting necessary correction in software for updation. CHSE shall engaged a Nodal Officer, especially to deal with admission / transfer / readmission cases to ensure disposal of cases within 48 hours from the receipt of the cases, so that allegations for delay at CHSE level may be minimized.
4. Rs. 20/- per Registration out of CSHE fees towards on-line issue of registration number shall be deposited by respective colleges directly in "OCAC-SAMS Central Fund, Odisha" bank account opened by Orissa Computer Application Center (OCAC), Bhubaneswar. The balance fees shall be deposited with CHSE (O) as per the previous procedure. The details of bank information to which the amount will be transferred through RTGS / NEFT by the colleges is as follows.
